THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL:

His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Associate Minister of National Defence and the Minister of Public Works, is pleased hereby, effective April 1, 1964,

(a) pursuant to section 35 of the Public Works Act, to transfer from the Minister of National Defence to the Minister of Public Works the management, charge and direction of the Northwest Highway System comprising

- (i) the Alaska Highway extending from Mile 84 in the vicinity of Port. St. John, British Columbia, to Mile 1221 in the Yukon Territory at the Alaska boundary,
  - (ii) the Haines Highway extending from Mile 1221 its junction with the Alaska Highway near Mile 1016 of the latter, to Mile 42, at the Alaska boundary in British Columbia, and
  - (iii) all other property forming part of the Northwest Highway System or used in connection with it except
    - (A) all property at Dawson Creek, British Columbia, under the control of the Minister of National Defence, and
    - (B) the Rifle range at Whitehorse;
- (c) pursuant to the Public Service Rearrangement and Transfer of Duties Act, to transfer from the Minister of National Defence to the Minister of Public Works the powers, duties or functions of the Minister of National Defence in respect of the administration of leases, utility and service contracts, licences and other

agreements or arrangements of a contractual nature relating to the administration, control, management or operation of the Northwest Highway System and under which Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada has any rights or obligations; and

- (c) to transfer from the Minister of National Defence to the Minister of Public Works the administration and control of all supplies and equipment used in connection with the maintenance, repair, control or management of the Northwest Highway System except military supplies and equipment.
