This ceremonial document is signed in recognition and respect of the Agreement between Yukon and Canada (Gas Tax Agreement), as signed by the Ministers of Canada and Yukon, and of the principles and commitments enshrined in that Gas Tax Agreement.

Both parties recognize the value of the New Deal for Cities and Communities regionally and nationally;

Both parties acknowledge and support the principles enshrined by the New Deal, specifically:

1. Respect for jurisdiction

4. Promotion of long-term solutions
5. Transparency
6. Regular reporting to Canadians;

Both parties acknowledge that the Gas Tax Agreement has the potential to provide long-term benefits to all Yukon communities, while developing and improving intergovernmental relationships, at all levels;

Both parties recognize and respect the effort and value of Yukon First Nations and the Association of Yukon Communities provided in concluding the Gas Tax Agreement;

Both parties acknowledge and respect the abilities and capacities of all orders of government in executing the Gas Tax Agreement.


Given the acknowledgement and recognition of the above by both parties, let this document stand as a public recognition of the Gas Tax Agreement.


