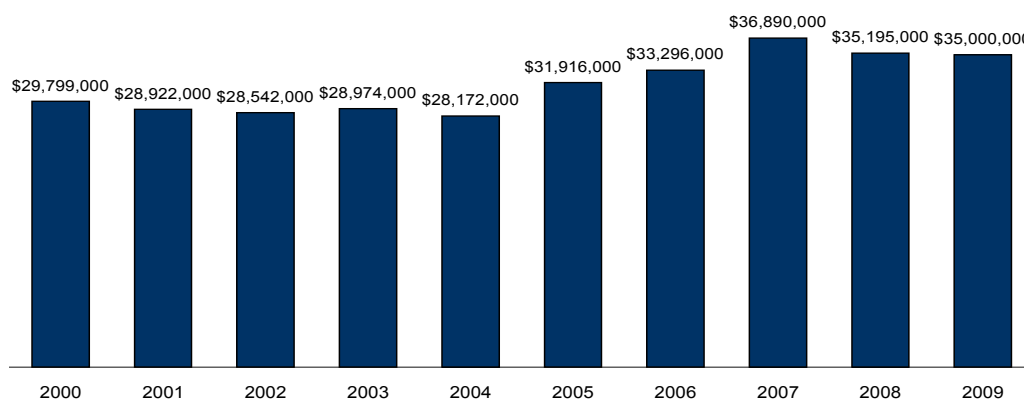


Yukon RRSP Contributions 2009

Contributions to RRSPs, Canada and Yukon, 2009

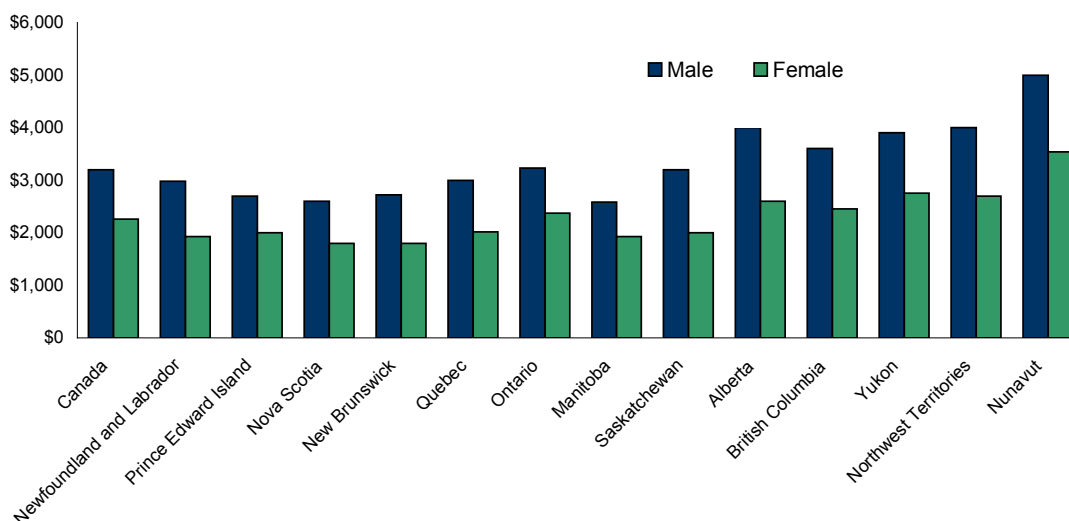
In 2009, Canadians contributed \$33.0 billion to registered retirement savings plans (RRSPs), a decrease of \$315 million, or 0.9%, from the 2008 total of \$33.3 billion. The number of Canadians contributing to RRSPs decreased by 3.4%, from 6,178,900 in 2008 to 5,967,710 in 2009.

Yukoners contributed \$35.0 million to RRSPs in 2009, down \$200,000, or 0.6%, from the 2008 total of \$35.2 million. The number of Yukoners contributing to RRSPs was also down, from 6,200 in 2008 to 5,940 in 2009, a decrease of 260 people, or 4.2%.

Nationally, the median RRSP contribution in 2009 was \$2,680, down \$20 from 2008. Yukon recorded the fourth-highest median RRSP contribution (\$3,160). Nunavut reported the highest median contribution at \$4,250, the Northwest Territories the second-highest at \$3,450, and Alberta was the third-highest at \$3,200.

Characteristics of RRSP Contributors, 2009

- ◆ While women in Yukon represented 50% of the tax-filing population in 2009, they accounted for 53% of the number of RRSP contributors and 45% of total dollar contributions. Compared to the rest of the country, Yukon recorded the highest proportion of women contributors, and therefore, the lowest proportion of male contributors (47%). Yukon was the only province or territory where female contributors outnumbered males. The median RRSP contribution was higher for men than for women in all provinces and territories.
- ◆ In 2009, 22% of the total number of contributors in Yukon were under the age of 35, with their dollar contributions representing 12% of the total. Persons aged 35 to 44 accounted for 23% of contributors and 20% of contributions, while those aged 45 to 54 accounted for the largest percentage of total contributors and contributions, at 30% and 32%, respectively. Yukoners closest to retirement (aged 55 to 64) accounted for 22% of the total number of contributors and 31% of total dollar contributions.
- ◆ Nunavut and the Northwest Territories had the lowest average age of contributors (42 years) in 2009. The average Canadian RRSP contributor was 45 years, the same as in 2008. Yukon contributors' average age in 2009 remained at 45, the same as the previous four years.
- ◆ Nationally, the median employment income for RRSP contributors increased less than one percent, from \$51,090 in 2008 to \$51,570 in 2009. Yukon's median employment income for RRSP contributors was the third highest in the country at \$62,670, also an increase of less than one percent from the 2008 figure of \$62,210.
