Yukon Census Historical Population 1901 to 2016

The following table shows historical Yukon census subdivision (CSD) population figures based on Statistics Canada's census counts (not adjusted for net undercoverage). Censuses were conducted every ten years from 1901 until 1951; every five years from 1956.
