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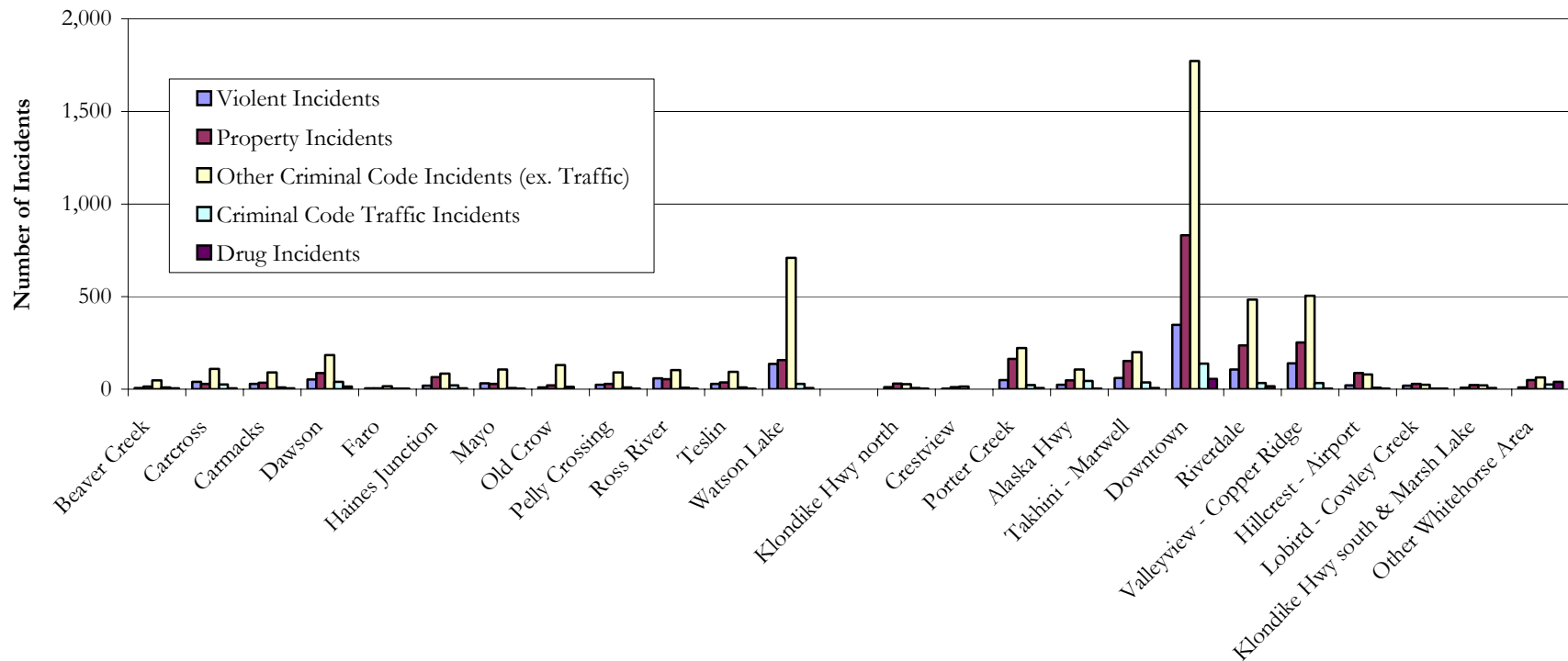
YUKON CRIME STATISTICS, 1995-2003

Introduction

The Yukon crime statistics included in this publication are derived from analysis of occurrence reports created and maintained by Yukon detachments of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP). Occurrence reports contain information on all official RCMP activities, in particular, investigations of reported criminal activity. In compiling these crime statistics, the Bureau has concentrated on incidents reported by the RCMP that represent offences under Canada's Criminal Code or drug statutes.

Most of the charts and tables in this publication encompass all relevant offences. This contrasts with the national data produced by Statistics Canada which include only the most serious offence in each incident. In order to enable comparisons with national data, the charts on pages 119 through 129 have been generated using the most serious offence convention. See the definitions on pages 2 and 3 for more information.

Concepts and Definitions

Classification of Reported Criminal Code Incidents

Criminal Code incidents are sub-divided into four major groupings: (i) violent incidents, (ii) property incidents, (iii) other Criminal Code incidents (except traffic), and (iv) Criminal Code traffic incidents.

Violent incidents include offences that deal with the application, or threat of application, of force to a person. These include homicide, attempted murder, various forms of sexual and non-sexual assault, robbery, and abduction. Traffic incidents that result in death or injury are included under Criminal Code traffic incidents.

Property incidents involve unlawful acts with the intent of gaining property but do not involve the threat or use of force against an individual. Examples of property crimes are breaking and entering, fraud, and possession of stolen goods.

Other Criminal Code incidents involve the remaining Criminal Code offences that are not classified as violent or property incidents (excluding traffic). Examples are property damage, bail violation, breach of probation, disturbing the peace, arson, prostitution, and offensive weapons.

Criminal Code traffic incidents include dangerous operation of motor vehicles, impaired operation of motor vehicles, failure to provide breath or blood sample, failure to remain at scene of an accident, and driving while prohibited.

Most Serious Offence

The “incident” is the basis for counting reported crime. An incident is the set of connected events usually constituting an occurrence report. National data compiled by Statistics Canada classify incidents according to the most serious offence occurring in the incident (generally the offence which carries the longest maximum sentence under the Criminal Code of Canada). In categorizing incidents, violent offences always take precedence over non-violent offences. In order to facilitate comparison with national statistics, the charts on pages 119 through 129 of this report are compiled utilizing the most serious offence convention. All other statistics count all actual incidents.

Counting Incidents

For violent crimes, a separate incident is recorded for each victim. If, for example, one person assaults three people, then three incidents are recorded. If three people assault one person, only one incident is recorded. For non-violent crimes, one incident is counted for every distinct or separate occurrence. Robbery is one exception to this rule. Robbery is categorized as a violent crime. Unlike all other violent offences, one occurrence of robbery is equal to one incident, regardless of the number of victims.

Thus, the total number of incidents is not a census of all violations of the law that come to attention of police. Rather, it is equal to the number of victims of violent crimes (other than robberies) plus the number of separate occurrences of non-violent crimes (and robberies).

“Actual” and “Unfounded” Incidents

When a crime is reported to the police, the incident is recorded as a “reported” incident. Police then conduct a preliminary investigation to determine the validity of the report. Occasionally, crimes reported to the police prove to be unfounded. Unfounded incidents are subtracted from the number of reported incidents to produce the number of “actual incidents”. Unfounded incidents have been removed from all data presented in this report.

Clearance of Actual Incidents

Criminal incidents can be either be cleared “by charge” or “cleared otherwise”. When a police investigation leads to the identification of a suspect, an “information” is laid against that person (i.e., the person is formally charged). From a statistical point of view, the laying of an information means that at least one actual incident can be “cleared by charge”. An incident can be cleared even if the police have not apprehended the person, provided that the person has been identified and there is sufficient evidence to lay a charge.

Incidents can also be “cleared otherwise”. In some cases, police cannot lay an information even if they have identified a suspect and there is enough evidence to support the laying of an information. Examples include instances where the

complainant declines to proceed with charges against the accused, or cases where the alleged offender died before he or she can be formally charged. In other cases, the police use their discretion to employ alternative measures of resolution. Examples include family group conferencing, circle sentencing, and informal methods of conflict resolution. These typically involve consultation with the victim. Such incidents are considered to be “cleared otherwise”, that is, other than by the laying of a charge.

Since the process of solving crime is often time-consuming, a criminal incident may be solved months or even years after it was reported to police and recorded on the RCMP database. For this reason, it is important to keep in mind the date when the reported data were generated by the RCMP. In this report, the 1995 data were generated in May 1996; data for 1996 through 1998, May 1999; data for 1999, April 2000; data for 2000, April 2001; data for 2001, April 2002; data for 2002, May 2003; data for 2003, April 2004. Data generated since those dates would show different results than those included in this document.

Persons Charged

The RCMP database also records the number of persons charged. For incidents that are cleared, these items are collected: number of adults charged by gender and the number of youths (aged 12 to 17 years) charged by gender. The “persons charged” category includes the number of people charged or recommended for charges by the police, not the number of charges laid or recommended against those people. For purposes of comparison with national statistics, a person who is simultaneously charged with more than one offence is counted according to the most serious offence, even if the offences occurred in more than one incident. In addition, persons may be counted more than once throughout the year; that is, individuals are counted on each occasion that they are charged by police.

“Persons charged” refers to persons who were charged in connection with a particular incident. These persons, however, may have been charged later with a lesser offence. For example, a person who commits a breaking and entering offence may end up being charged with possession of stolen goods if, for instance, the police have better evidence on the latter offence. Both the “actual incident” and the “persons charged” are counted under breaking and entering, even though the person was actually charged with possession of stolen goods.

Coverage of Yukon RCMP Detachment Areas

Carcross includes Tagish and Jakes Corner.

Haines Junction includes Burwash Landing, Destruction Bay, and Champagne.

Mayo includes Stewart Crossing, Elsa, and Keno.

Teslin includes Johnsons Crossing.

Watson Lake includes Upper Liard, 2 & 2-1/2 Mile Villages, and Rancheria.

All others self-explanatory.

Whitehorse Neighbourhoods

Klondike Highway north includes MacPherson/Hidden Valley, Takhini River, and Klondike Highway north.

Takhini - Marwell includes Takhini, Marwell, Two Mile Hill, and Mountainview Drive.

Downtown includes Yukon River, South Access area, and Downtown.

Valleyview - Copper Ridge includes Hamilton Blvd., Valleyview, McIntyre/Kwanlin Dun, Arkell, Logan, Granger, and Copper Ridge.

Lobird - Cowley Creek includes Lobird, McCrae, Pineridge, Wolf Creek, Mary Lake, and Cowley Creek.

All others self-explanatory.

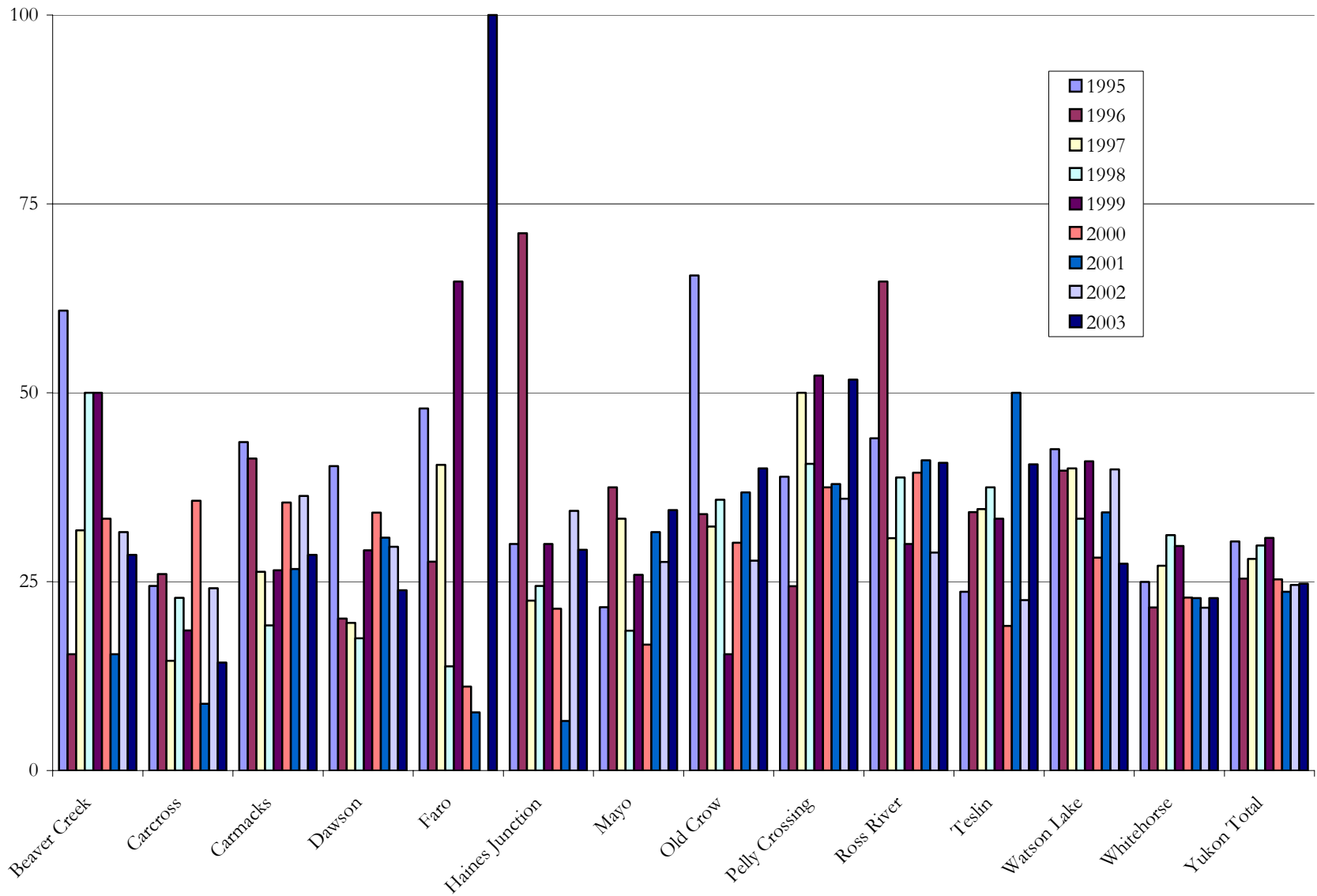

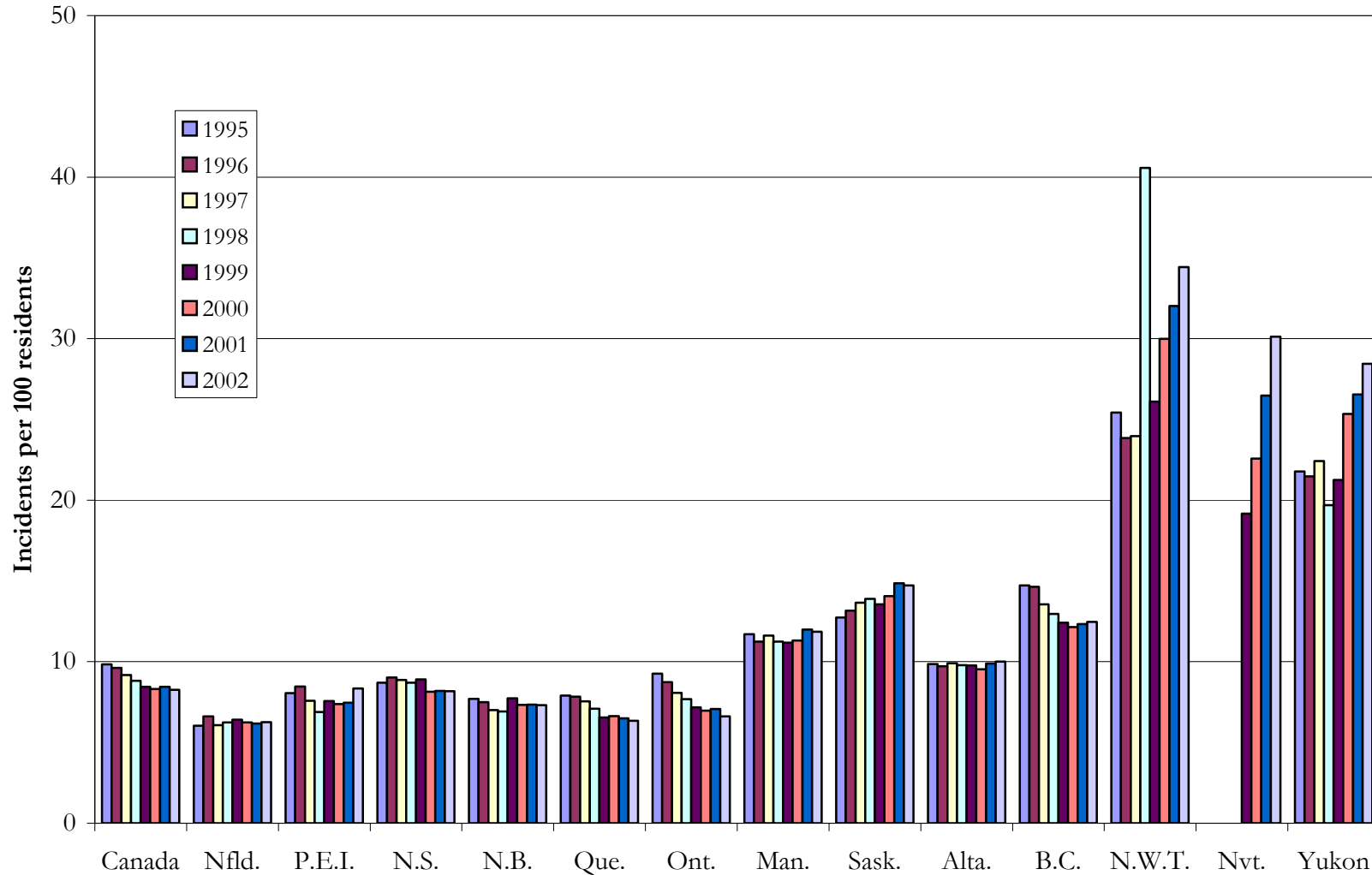

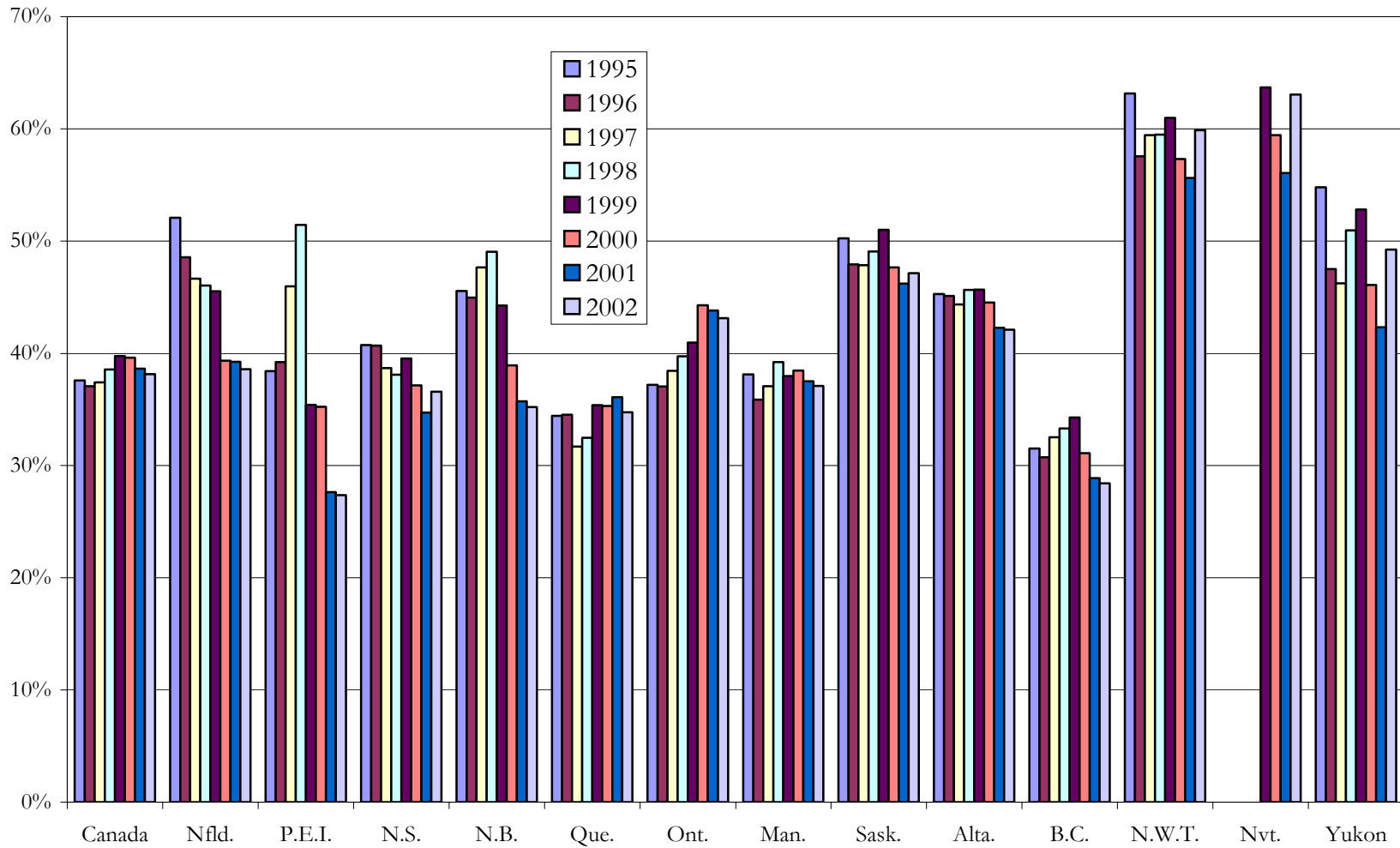

Reported Crime Rate per 100 Residents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



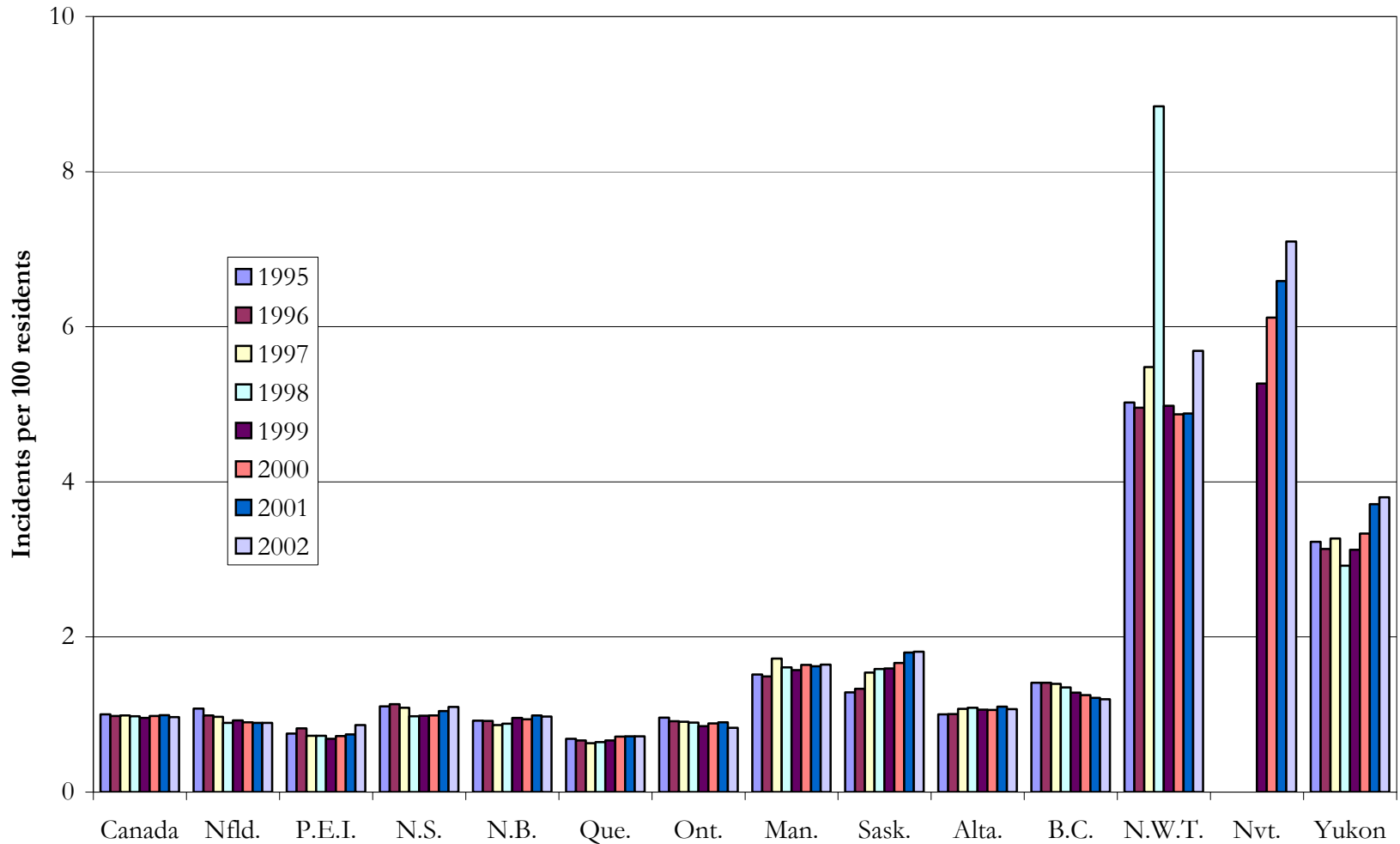

Clearance Rate of All Reported Criminal Code and Drug Incidents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



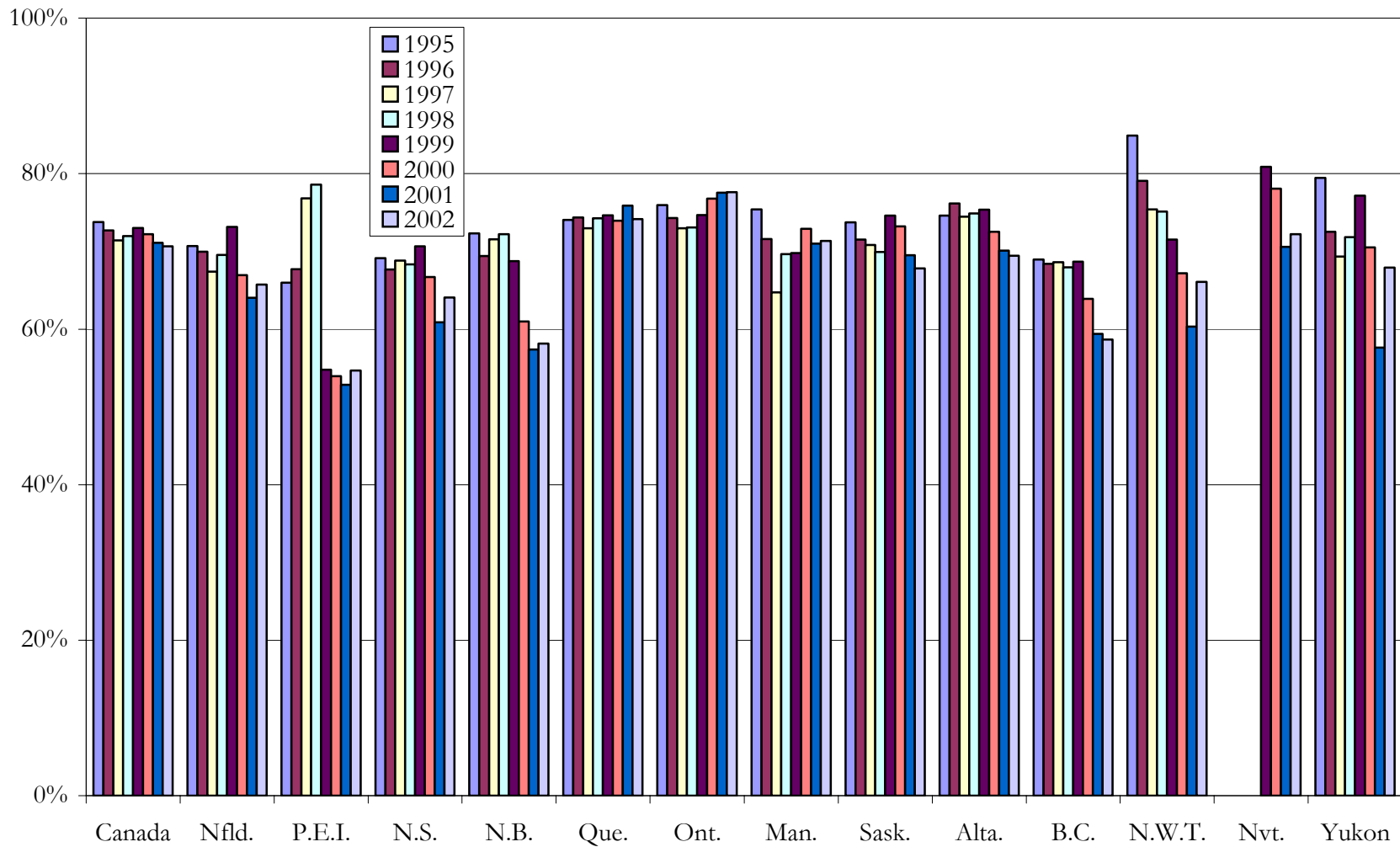

Reported Violent Incident Rate per 100 Residents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



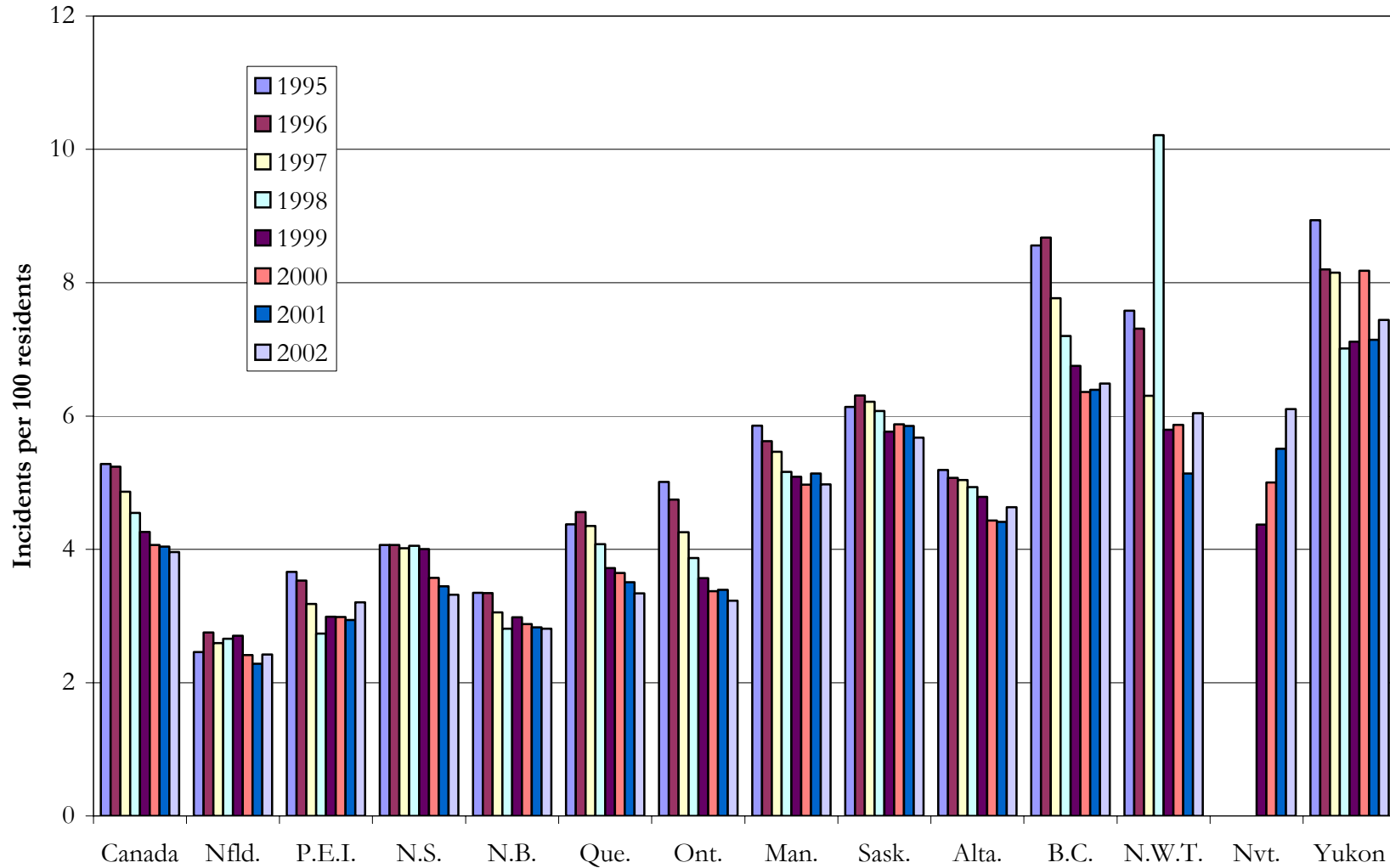

Clearance Rate of Violent Incidents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



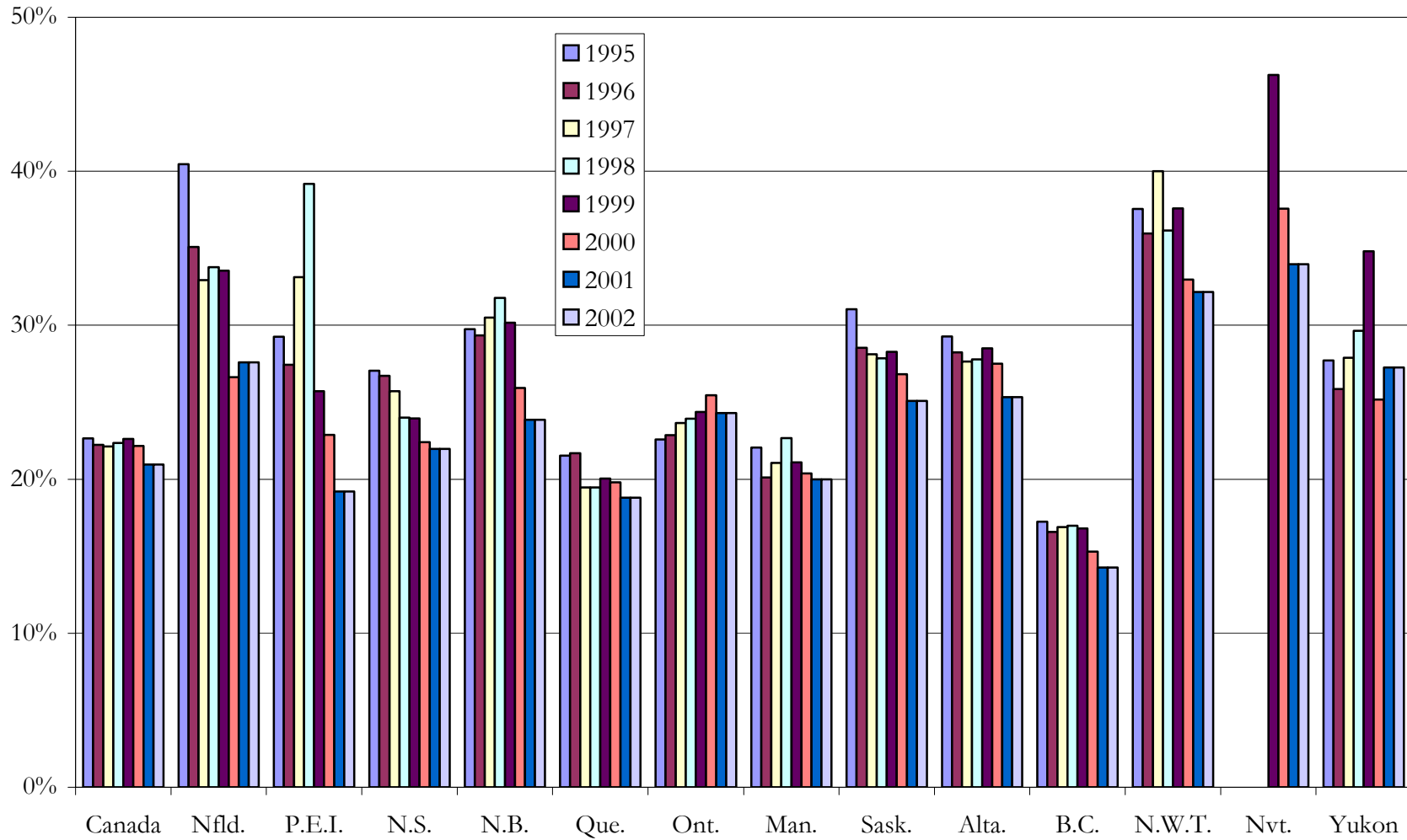

Reported Property Incident Rate per 100 Residents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



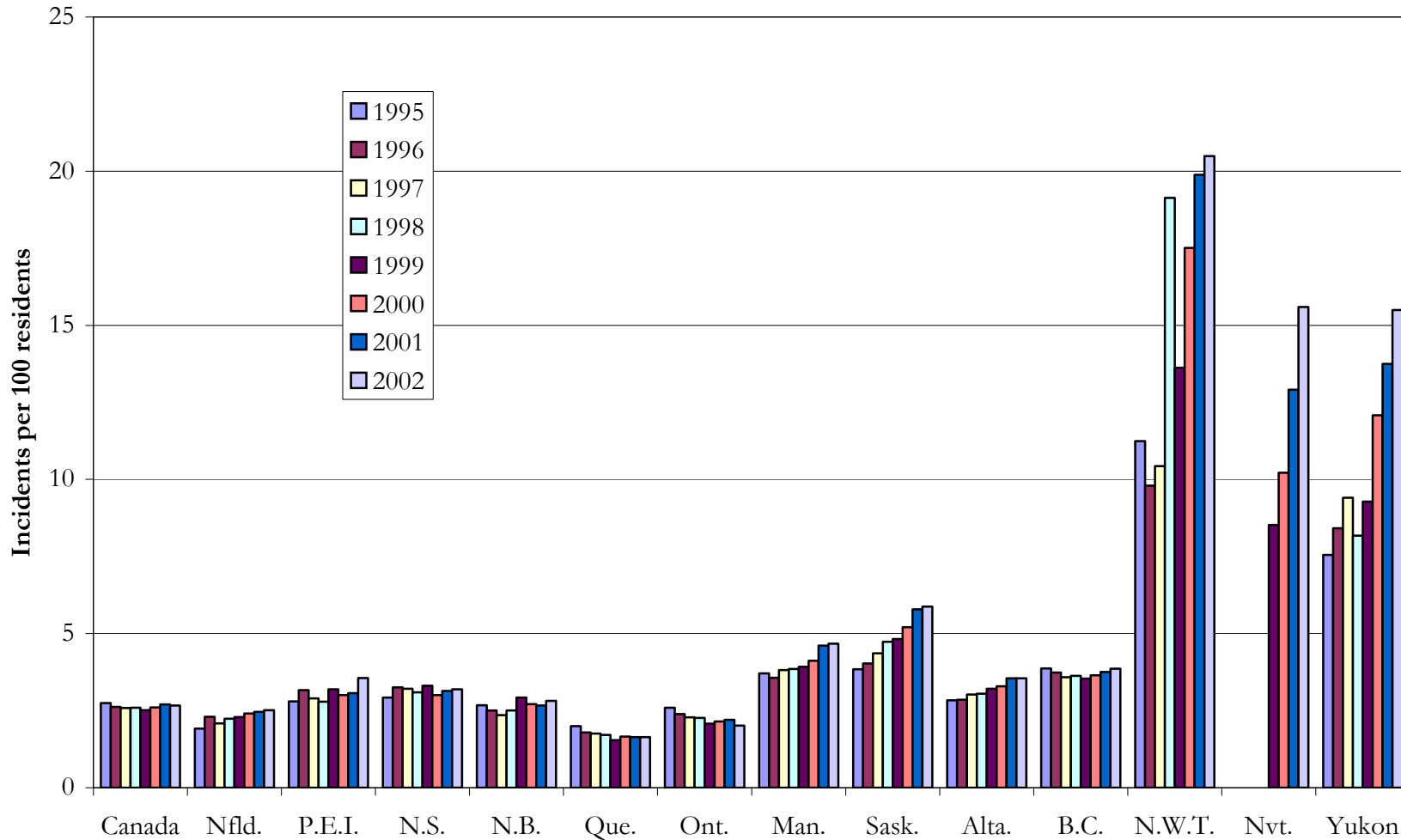

Clearance Rate of Property Incidents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



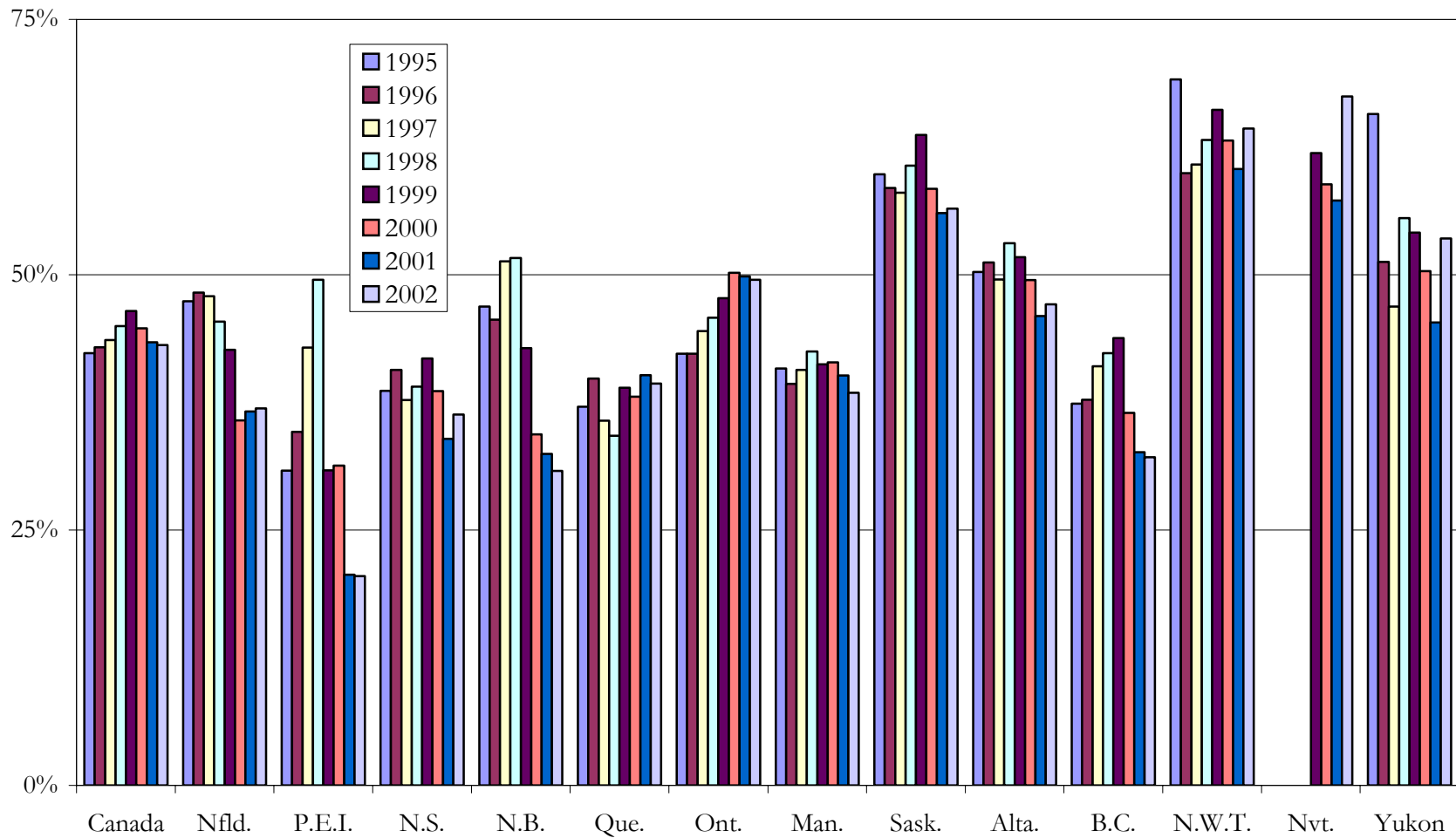

Reported Other Criminal Code Incident Rate per 100 Residents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



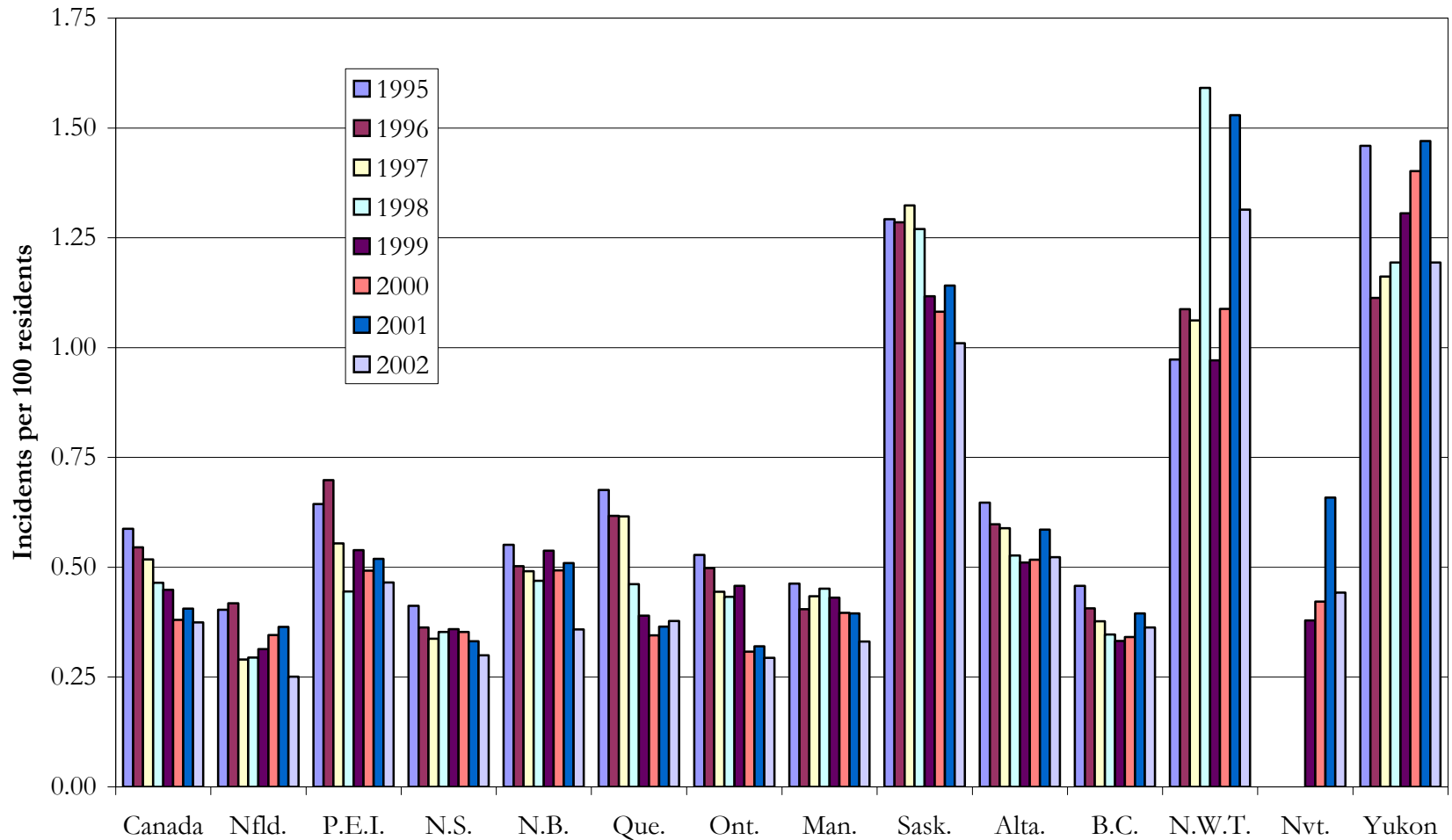

Clearance Rate of Other Criminal Code Incidents, according to the Most Serious Offence rule, 1995-2002, by Province/Territory



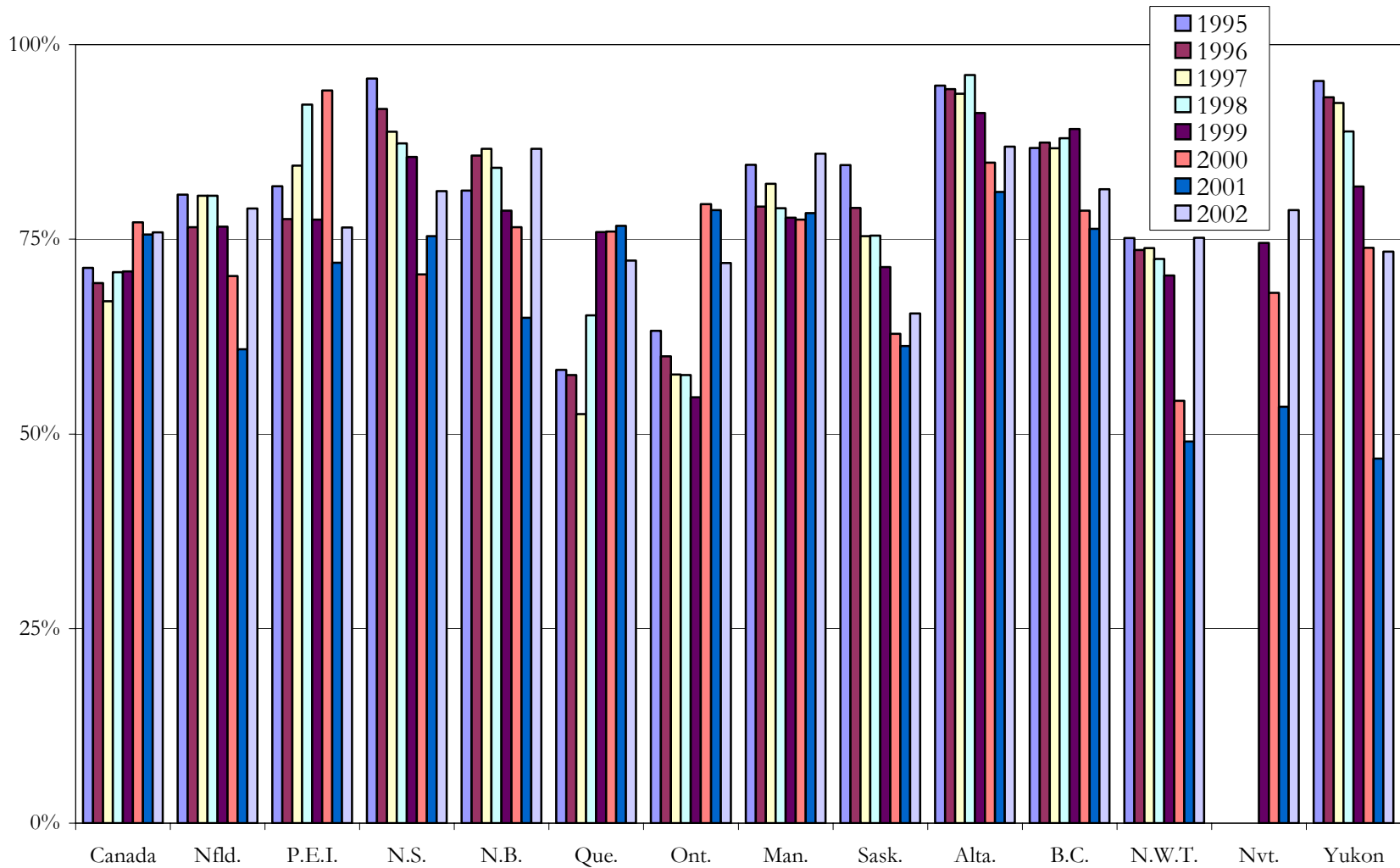
