

Earnings & Total Income

The following statistics are from the 1996 Census of Canada which occurred on May 14, 1996.

1— Employment Income

The average employment income in the Yukon for 1990 was \$28,828. In 1995 the average was \$28,511, a decrease of 1.1%.

Over 21% of Yukon men with employment income earned \$50,000 or more in 1995, compared with 9.6% of Yukon women with employment income. The average employment income for Yukon men was \$31,651 compared with \$24,997 for Yukon women, a difference of 21.0%.

Between 1990 and 1995, the largest increase in a single employment income group was for those earning between \$60,000 and \$74,999 (up 32.6%) and those earning between \$2,000 and \$4,999 (up 32.5%).

Compared with Canada, the Yukon had a far lower percentage of its population aged 15 and over without employment income. 33.7% of Canadians reported no employment income compared with 16.7% in the Yukon. The average employment income for Canadians was \$26,474 compared with \$28,511 in the Yukon.

Notes

Employment Income/Earnings: Refers to total income received by persons 15 years of age and over during 1995 as: wages and salaries, net non-farm income from unincorporated business and/or professional practice or net farm income.

Total Income: Refers to the total money income received from the following sources during the calendar year 1995 by persons 15 years of age and over: wages and salaries (total); net farm income; net non-farm income from unincorporated business and/or professional practice; federal Child Tax benefits; Old Age Security pension and Guaranteed Income Supplement; benefits from Canada or Quebec Pension Plan; benefits from Unemployment Insurance; other income from government sources; dividends, interest on bonds, deposits and savings certificates, and other investment income; retirement pensions, superannuation and annuities, including those from RRSPs and RRIFs; and other money income.

Average Income: Refers to the weighted mean income of individuals 15 years of age and over who reported income. Average income is calculated from unrounded data by dividing the aggregate income of a specified group of individuals by the number of individuals with income in that group.
