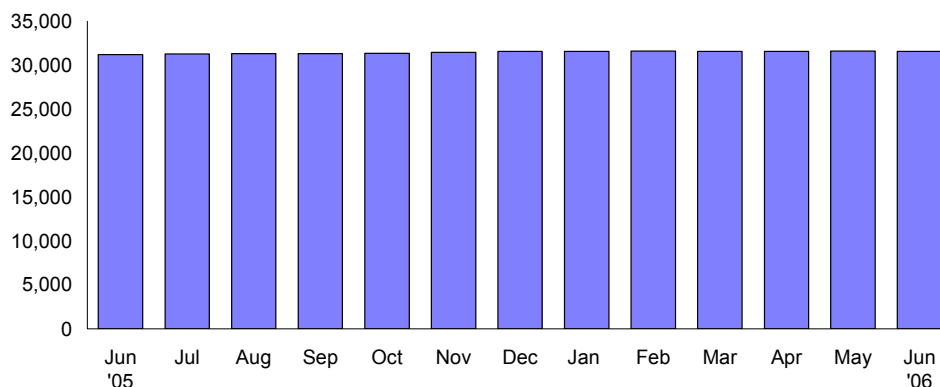


1 Monthly Yukon Population Estimates for 2005 & 2006

- Between June 2005 and June 2006, the monthly population of the Yukon increased from a low of 31,222 in June 2005 to a high of 31,630 in May 2006, a variation of 408 people.
- The average population of the Yukon over the last twelve months (July 2005 to June 2006) was 31,502. This is an increase of 532 persons, or 1.7%, from the 2004/05 average of 30,970 for the same time period.
- Over the last twelve months, the Yukon's population has increased steadily in the latter half of 2005, followed by slight fluctuations in the first six months of 2006.

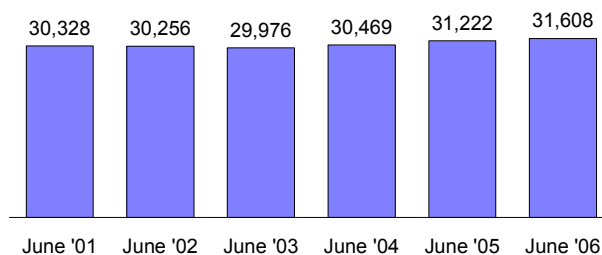

The Yukon's Population In June, 2001 to 2006



As of June 2006, the population of the Yukon was **31,608**. This is the highest population for any June since 1998. This is also the third consecutive June population increase after six consecutive decreases in the June population after the Faro mine closure in 1997.

- In June 2006, the Yukon's population consisted of 15,798 males (49.98%) and 15,810 females (50.02%).
- There were 5,754 people (18.2%) under 15 years of age, 23,522 (74.4%) between 15 and 64 years of age, and 2,332 people (7.4%) who were 65 years of age or older.

4 Community Populations by Month

- In the larger communities, Whitehorse's population increased by 1.6%, Dawson City decreased 2.5%, Watson Lake's population decreased 0.5%, and in Haines Junction the population decreased 1.5% from June 2005 to June 2006.
- As of January 2002, Marsh Lake is now being counted separately as a community. However, it should be noted that only residents whose mailing address is Marsh Lake are included in the community data for the purposes of this report. As of June 2006, there were 367 residents who received their mail at Marsh Lake, while the Census 2001 count for the area was 400 residents. Increases in Marsh Lake population figures are attributable in part to the changing of postal addresses from Whitehorse to Marsh Lake.

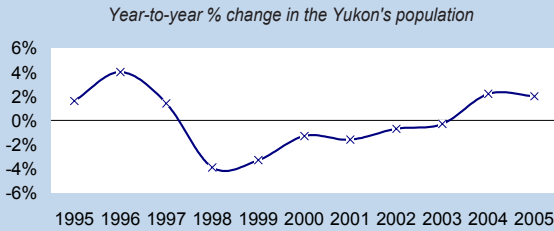

5 Historical Population Estimates

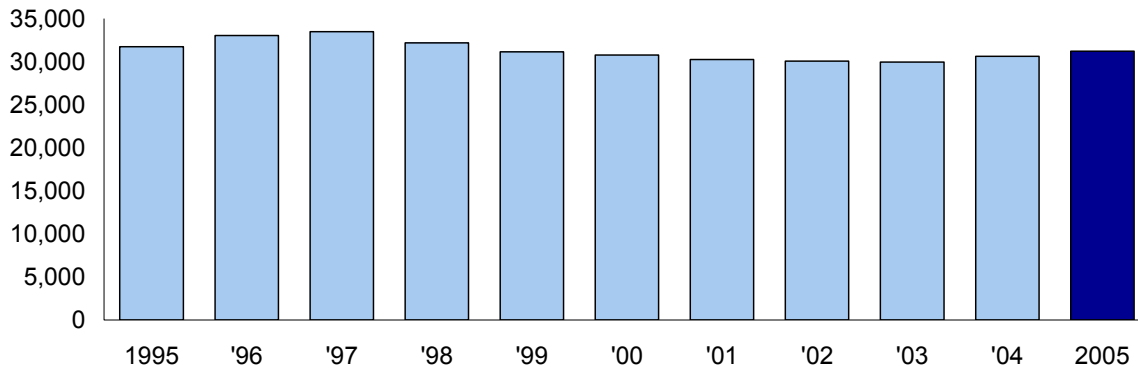
- Comparing 1995 to 2005, the population of the Yukon decreased by 538 people (from 31,778 to 31,240). This represents an average annual growth rate of -0.2%. However, this growth has not occurred evenly from year to year. Rather, it has ranged from a high of 4.0% between '95 and '96 to a low of -3.9% between '97 and '98.

Population estimates are used by the public sector, private sector and the general public. The Yukon Bureau of Statistics produces population estimates twice a year. Figures for the months of January to June are released in July of the same year while population estimates for the months of July to December are released in January of the next year.

These population estimates are statistically based on the Yukon Health Care Registration file. The figures are sorted by postal codes and community codes. Users of this information should be aware that the community population includes not only the legally defined city limits, but also the population that lives in the immediately surrounding area.
