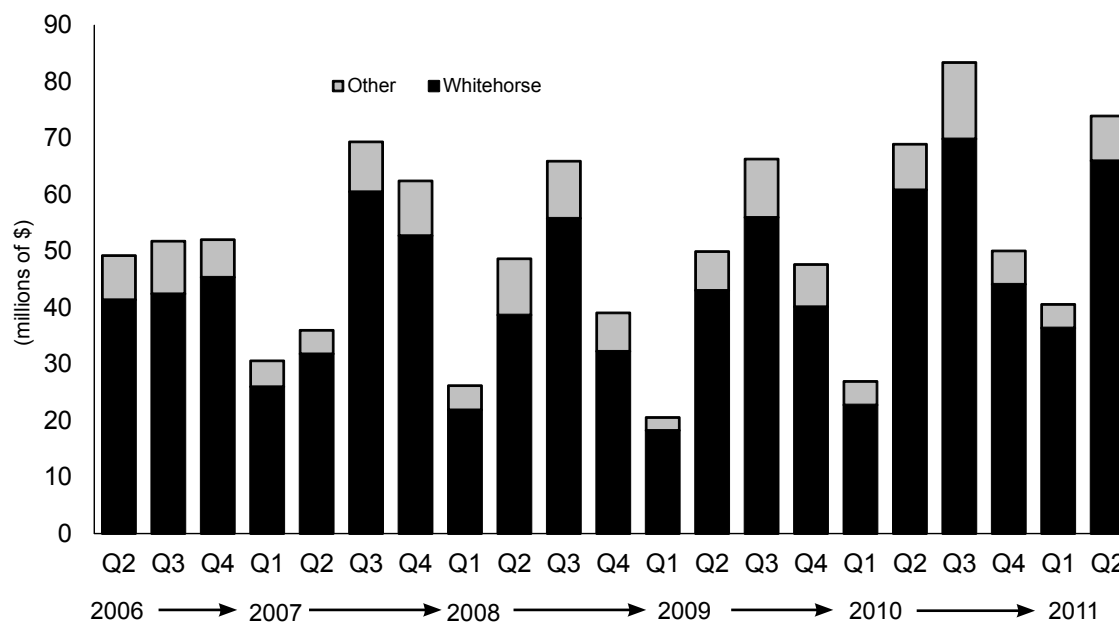
The total value of real estate transactions in Yukon for the second quarter of 2011 was \$73,925,300. This is the highest value of any second quarter on record. This is an increase of \$5,008,400, or 7.3%, compared with the second quarter of 2010 which was \$68,916,900.

On a year-to-date basis, real estate transactions in Yukon (January through June) for 2011 totalled \$110,319,400 compared to \$95,826,700 for the same time period in 2010. This represents an increase of \$14,492,800, or 15.1%.

In Whitehorse for the second quarter of 2011, the value of transactions totalled \$65,987,000, also a record high for a second quarter. This is an increase of \$5,150,500, or 8.5%, compared to the second quarter of 2010.

In the rest of Yukon, the value of real estate transactions in the second quarter of 2011 totalled \$7,938,400. This is a decrease \$142,000, or 1.8%, compared to the same time period in 2010.

Value and Type of Real Estate Transactions in Whitehorse

The value of real estate transactions in Whitehorse increased \$5,150,500 or 8.5%, comparing the second quarter of 2011 (\$65,987,000) to the second quarter of 2010 (\$60,836,500).

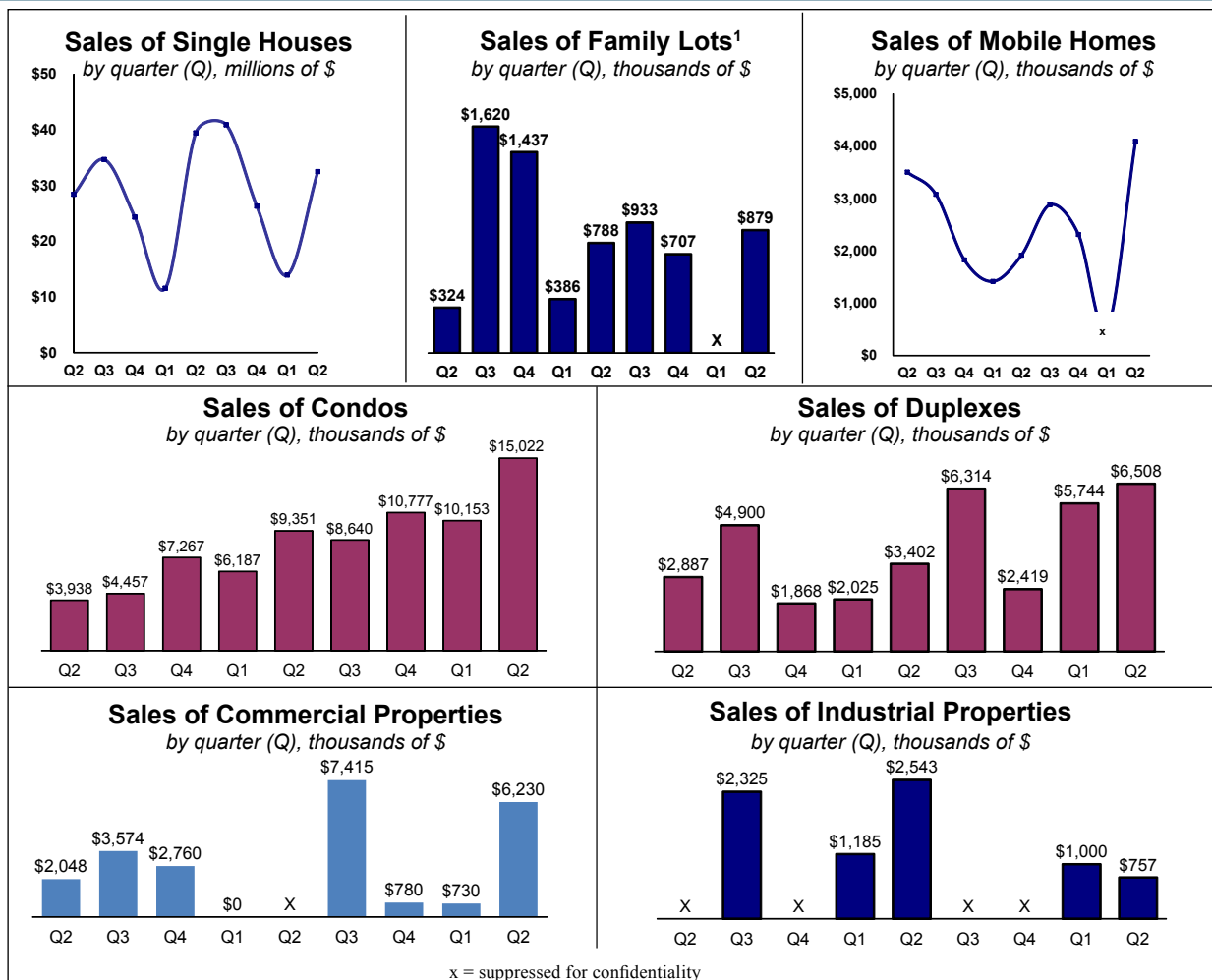

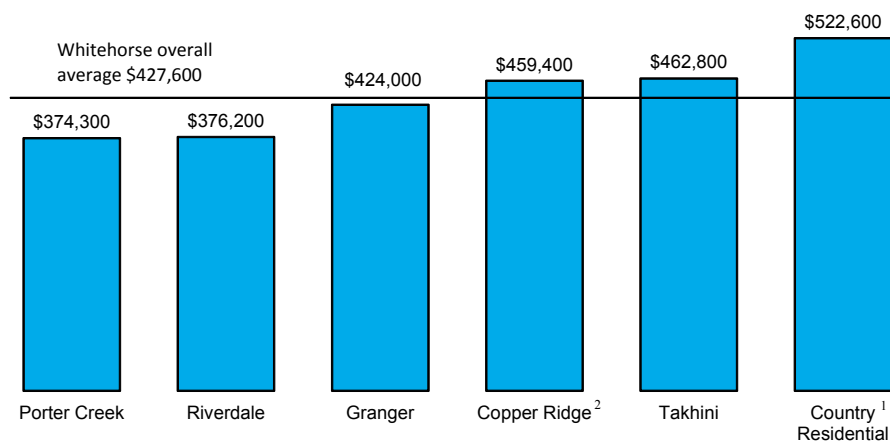

- The **average** single house price (does not include duplexes, condos or mobile homes) in Whitehorse in the second quarter of 2011 was \$427,600- a new record high. This is an increase of \$58,800 or 15.9% compared to the second quarter of 2010 (\$368,800).
- The **median** (50% of sales above this figure and 50% below) single house price in Whitehorse in the second quarter of 2011 was also a record high at \$417,500. One year earlier in the second quarter of 2010 the median house price was \$358,000.

Average Price of Single Houses Sold, Second Quarter, 2011

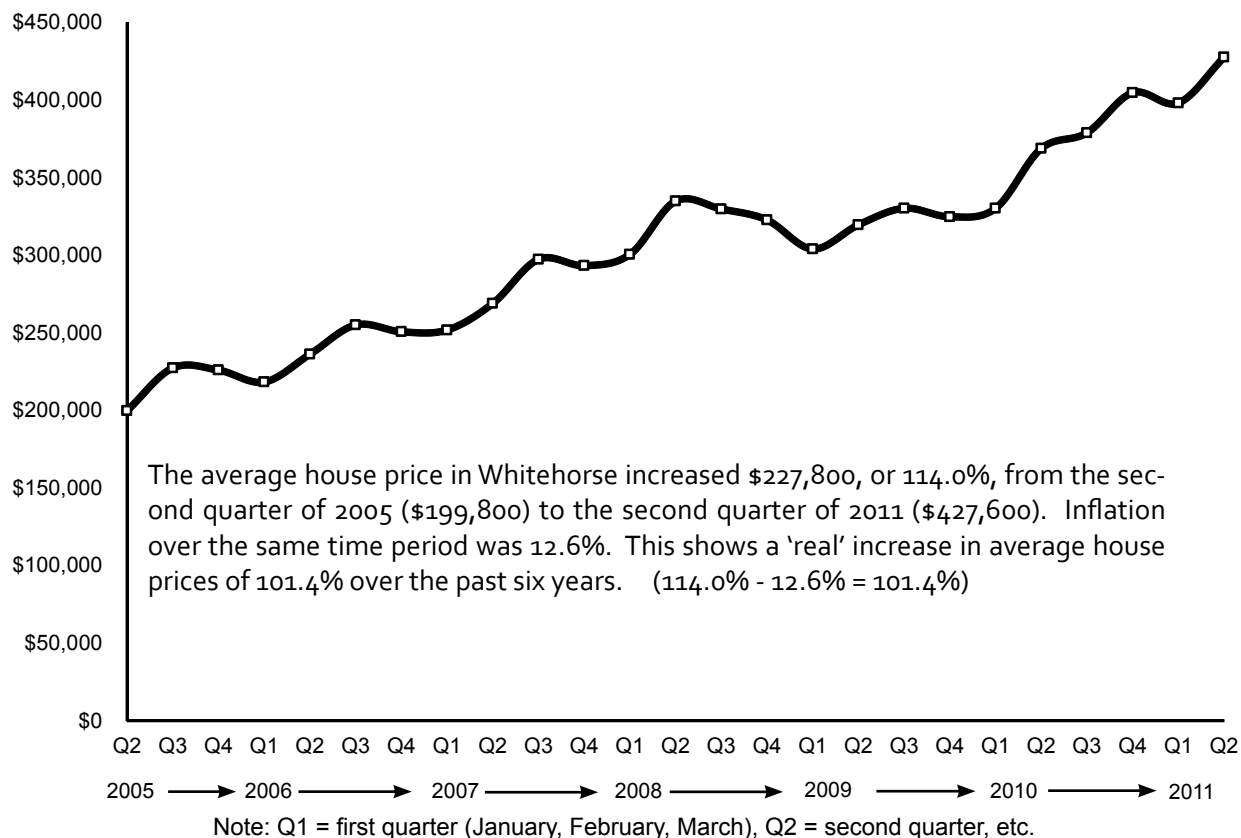

Average Single House Prices in Whitehorse



The Bureau of Statistics first undertook the Yukon Real Estate Survey in 1977. The survey is a census of all real estate transactions occurring anywhere in Yukon, with the exception of 'not-at-arm's-length' transactions ('not-at-arm's-length' transactions are those that do not reflect open market values). All single and multiple-residential property transactions, as well as commercial and industrial property sales, are included. The survey is divided into four parts: (1) Value of real estate transactions; (2) Type of real estate transactions in Whitehorse; (3) Value, number and average price of house sales in Whitehorse and (4) Average house prices in Whitehorse over the past six years.
